

How to submit your designs

When you want to submit a design you must supply a *thumbnail*, a *preview*, and a *print file* of the design.

Thumbnail

- Open the thumbnail file (.psd for Photoshop files and .eps for Illustrator files).
- Place the design in the centre of the box.
- Save for web and devices. Set the preset to PNG-24. Tick the Transparency checkbox. Leave Interlaced turned off. Then save the thumbnail (save as: *name of design_thumbnail*).

Preview

- Open the preview file (.psd for Photoshop files and .eps for Illustrator files).
- Place the design on the correct area of the shirt. In the preview file there are three rectangles:
 - Chest logos are placed in the “chest logo” box.
 - The “fits all items” is the box for which the design fits on all items.
 - The “total print size” is the maximum size that the design can be. You can move this box to place your design on different area.
- You can “turn on” different clothing items, so that you can preview how your design will look. If the design does not fit on all clothing items, that is not a problem. We will place your design only on clothing items on which it fits.
- Make sure that Shirt is again de-selected.
- Save for web and devices. Set the preset to PNG-24. Tick the Transparency checkbox. Leave Interlaced turned off. Then save the preview (save as: *name of design_preview*).

Print file

- For best quality printing it is better to use an Illustrator file type. All fonts need to be converted to outlines and the design should be saved as large as possible (minimum 20x29 cm or 29x20 cm). Images in CMYK (Euro standard coated) with resolution of at least 250 dpi. In addition, the file must be one layer with a transparent background.
- Photos or other Photoshop documents can be delivered as .psd.
- For placing the design on the clothing, it is important that there is no space around the design, so cut off the box around the design.
- Save as: *name of design_print*

Banner widget (optional)

- When supplying a banner for the header of a shop it must meet the following requirements: 340 x 60 pixels, with a dpi of 72.
- Save for web and devices. Set the preset to PNG-24. Turn on Transparency. Turn off Interlaced. Then save the Banner Widget (save as: *name of widget_banner*).
